• Midsummer 99 – Opposite colors of Midsummer 06



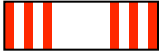
• Much Ado 00 – Festier colors of Much Ado 07



• Macbeth 00 – Tartan plaid



• Hamlet 00 – Can't have it be all black



• Henry VI 01 – White and Red roses making six stripes



• Twelfth Night 01 – Yellow crossed garters



• Lion in Winter 01 – It's a lion in winter



• Romeo & Juliet 02 – Two lovers separated by two house alike in dignity



• Tempest 02 – Prospero's sparkly over land and sea converging



• Troilus & Cressida 03 – Opposing Trojan and Greek colors



• Othello 03 – WWII khaki highlights black and white and blood



• As You Like It 03 – A brightness in Arden forest



• Richard III 04 – White dominant, Red on the fringes, three is offset



• Oedipus & Antigone 04 – 80's colors



• Hamlet 04 – Smaller stripe because Alan wasn't in it.

• Macbeth 05 – Black watch



• King John 05 – Six French and English rotating flats

• Tempest 08 – Land and sea converging



• Julius Caesar 08 – Roman triumvirate but a first among peers



• Spanish Tragedy 09 – Spanish and Portuguese and lots of blood



• Measure for Measure 09 – 4 beats



• Two Gentleman of Verona 09 – WWII pinks and greens



• The Boss – You directed or co-directed
